WHICH NEW BOOKS WILL YOU BE SEEING SOON?






WHAT ARE WE READING...

Fifteen years after the publication of *Twilight*, Stephanie Meyer has released *Midnight Sun*. This novel mirrors the first book in the Twilight series, but from the perspective of Edward Cullen.


While nothing revolutionary takes place in this book, *Midnight Sun* is a nice nostalgia trip for fans and a fun read. This book has all of the classic components Meyers gives us in her regular publications like over 600 pages worth of text and a strict adherence to the original plot. Readers will enjoy the fact that they explore the Twilight world in further depth and are given exactly what they expect. Some critics negatively review this book for that very aspect, in fact, while others praise it.
