We are incredibly grateful to the Ladd & Katherine Hauncher Library Foundation for helping us in this important reference revitalization for our library that will benefit our community!




WHAT ABOUT OUR OLDER REFERENCE BOOKS?

These older materials will be up for grabs to the public in order to make room for our brand new resources.


All reference materials will be free on a first-come-first-serve basis. If desired, patrons may donate to the library any amount they see fit.

- Passed out until we run out!




